

**BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE (BAC)****RESOLUTION NO. 52, s. 2023****Recommending Agency-to-Agency Under Negotiated Procurement as the Method of Procurement for the Low-level Tritium and Isotope Analysis of Five (5) CWD Pumping Stations**

WHEREAS, on 10 August 2023 Engineering Division requested for the Procurement of Isotope Analysis to Philippine Nuclear Research Institute (PNRI) which latter approved by the Head of Procuring Entity (HoPE);

WHEREAS, Engineering Division prepared Purchase Request (PR) No. 2023-06-0305 dated 27 June 2023 for the Low-level Tritium and Isotope Analysis of Five (5) CWD Pumping Stations with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos and 00/100 (Php120,750.00);

WHEREAS, Engineering Division intends to avail the services of the Philippine Nuclear Research Institute (PNRI) for the Low-level Tritium and Isotope Analysis of Five (5) CWD Pumping Stations with Accepted PNRI Portal Nuclear Services Online Application reference no. NAS20230824091129 and NAS20230824091446 in the amount of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos and 00/100 (Php120,750.00);

WHEREAS, Section 48.1, Rule XVI Alternative Methods of Procurement of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act provides that "Subject to the prior approval of the Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE), and whenever justified by the conditions provided in this Act, the Procuring Entity may, in order to promote economy and efficiency, resort to any of the alternative methods of procurement provided in this Rule. In all instances, the Procuring Entity shall ensure that the most advantageous price for the Government is obtained";

WHEREAS, Section 53 of the same IRR provides that Negotiated Procurement is a method of procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting services, whereby the Procuring Entity directly negotiates a contract with a technically, legally and financially capable supplier, contractor or consultant;

WHEREAS, Section 53.5 provides further that Agency-to-Agency is the Procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting Services from another agency of the GoP, such as the DBM-PS, which is tasked with a centralized procurement of Common-Use Supplies for the GoP in accordance with Letters of Instruction No. 755 and E.O. 359, s. 1989;



WHEREAS, Annex "H" Section V(D)(5)(b) of the same IRR sets the conditions for the procurement of Agency-to-Agency enumerated as follows:

- i. The Procuring Entity shall justify that entering into an Agency-to-Agency Agreement with the Servicing Agency is more efficient and economical to the government;
- ii. Servicing Agency has the mandate to deliver the goods and services required to be procured or to undertake the infrastructure project or consultancy required by the Procuring Agency;
- iii. Servicing Agency has the absorptive capacity to undertake the project;
- iv. Servicing Agency owns or has access to the necessary tools and equipment required for the project;
- v. Sub-contracting is not allowed. However, the servicing agency may implement the infrastructure project in-house, by job-order, or through the pakyaw contracting system; and
- vi. For procurement of infrastructure projects, the Servicing Agency must have a track record of having completed, or supervised a project, by administration or by contract, similar to and with a cost of at least fifty percent (50%) of the project at hand.

WHEREAS, upon review of the attached Request Letter for the Procurement of Isotope Analysis to Philippine Nuclear Research Institute (PNRI) to the Head of Procuring Entity (HoPE), Accepted PNRI Portal Nuclear Services Online Application with reference no. NAS20230824091129 and NAS20230824091446 and Purchase Request (PR) No. 2023-06-0305 for the procurement of the aforementioned project, the BAC finds that the above conditions for Agency-to-Agency are satisfied;

NOW THEREFORE, WE, the Members of the **Bids and Awards Committee**, by virtue of the powers vested on US by law, after considering request of the Implementing Office/End User, hereby resolve to recommend to the Head of Procuring Entity (HoPE), for her consideration and approval, the contract for the **Low-level Tritium and Isotope Analysis of Five (5) CWD Pumping Stations through Agency-to-Agency to Philippine Nuclear Research Institute (PNRI)** in the amount of **One Hundred Twenty Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos and 00/100 (Php120,750.00)**.
